Ventaja Panama Thanks You

Thank you so much to those who contributed to help us fulfill the 2023 *Ventaja* Panama initiative! **The Ventaja Panama STEM and Literacy camp completed its 7th year June 5-9, 2023** providing the weeklong camp program for children in grades K-12 in Panama City, Panama. This year launched a one-day program in Colon City, Panama as well for 18 students. This was the first year to return face to face since COVID disrupted the program.

The Ventaja Panama program is 3-fold providing: a) STEM and literacy instruction that is taught in Spanish and English, b) nutrition and meals that include daily breakfast and lunch, and c) a field trip tied to the academic experience and focus.
